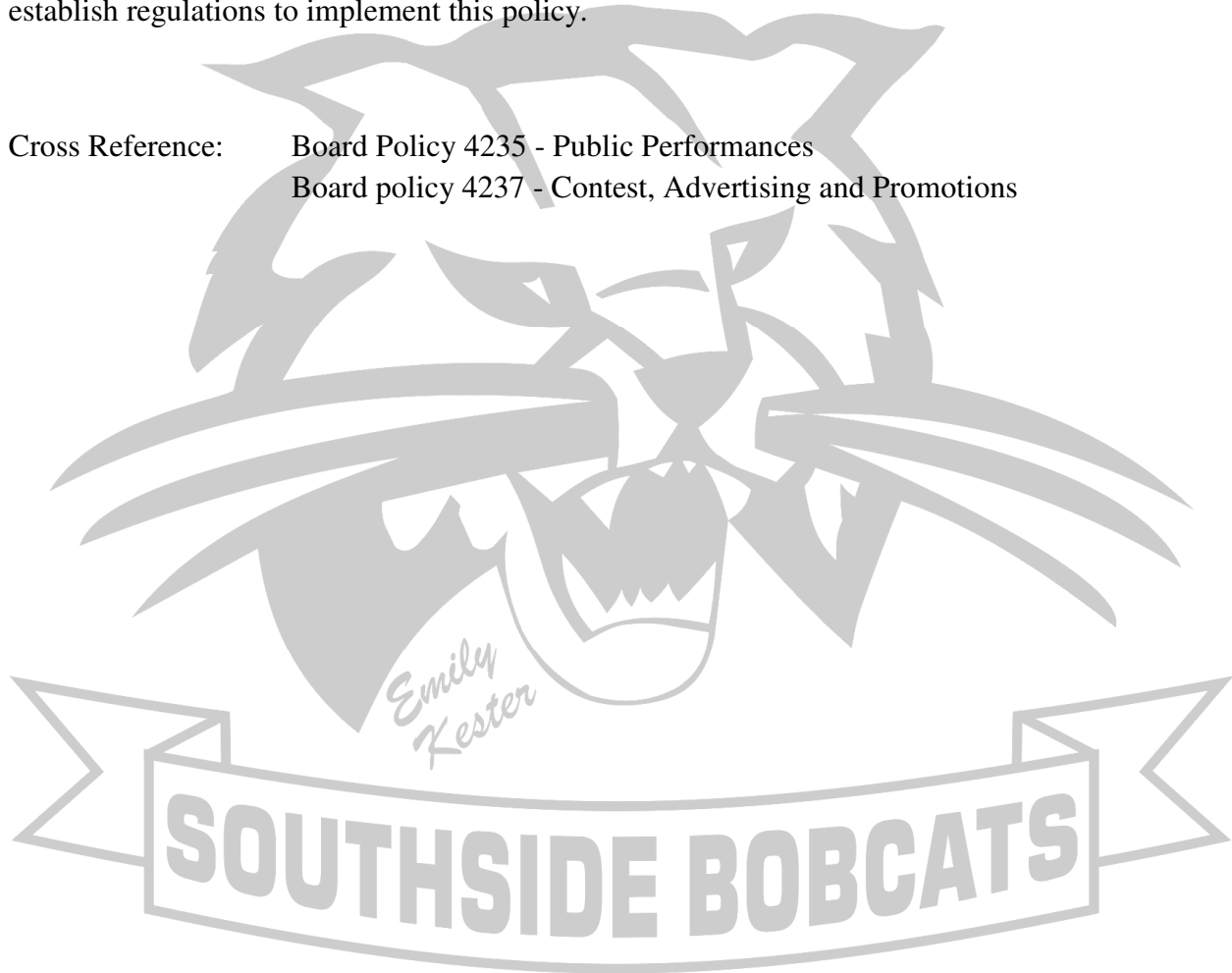


## COMMUNICATON WITH STUDENTS

The school may provide information about schools and school programs to students and parents. Information about non-school programs offered by non-profit organizations may be provided if it has been approved by the Superintendent or designee as having social, recreational, or educational value to the students. Any non-profit group that seeks to distribute information about its program shall submit a description to the Superintendent or designee describing the relationship of the proposed activity to the educational program. The Superintendent shall establish regulations to implement this policy.
