Southside Learning Model Considerations

Each stage in the learning model will be evaluated every 2 (two) weeks unless mandates, COVID-19 trends, or other factors dictate immediate action.

The Stages of the Learning Model are not fluid, and are dependent on current conditions of the pandemic.

Continuous Learning 2.0 (synonymous with Distance Learning) is an overhauled version of Spring 2020 Distance Learning with improved platform, technology, and expectations.

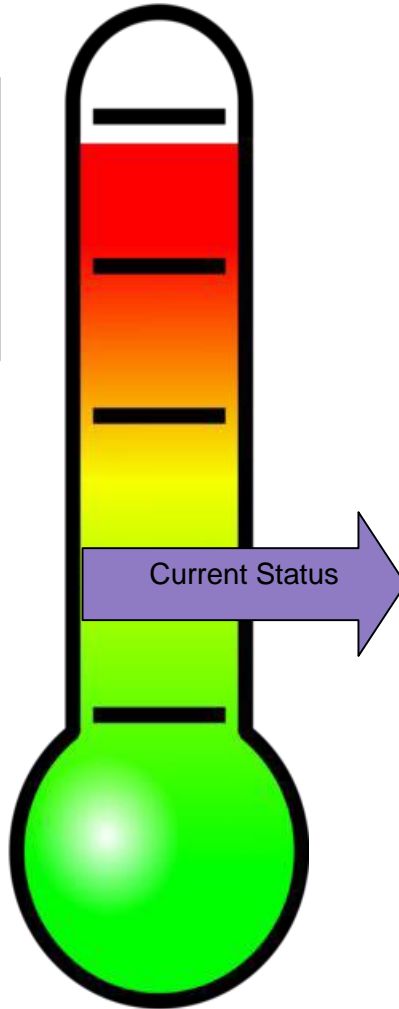
Hybrid Model refers to an AA/BB

- Students last name A-L attend Monday/Tuesday
- Students last name M-Z attend Thursday/Friday
- Continuous Learning 2.0 takes place when not face to face
- Every Wednesday Continuous Learning 2.0 for all remote
- students Families may opt for Continuous Learning 2.0

Calendar changes may be adjusted as needed.

Current Status

Southside Learning Model Status



Stage 1-All students and staff participate in Continuous Learning-School buildings closed to access.

Stage 2-All students participate in Continuous Learning-Staff able to be onsite for planning and online instruction delivery.

Stage 3-Continuous Learning with students of greatest need identified and onsite for face to face instruction 2 days per week.

Stage 4-Continuous Learning with additional identified students of need and learners onsite 2 days per week. Distance learning 3 days per week.

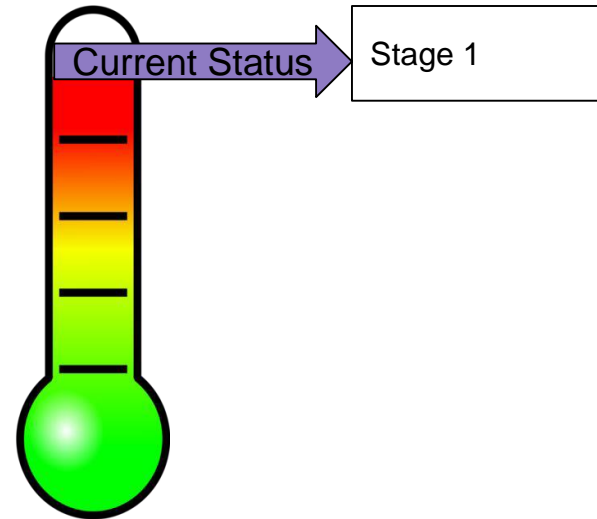
Stage 5-All students onsite for face to face instruction 4 days per week-distance learning 3 days per week.

Stage 6-All students onsite 5 days per week for face to face instruction.

Southside Learning Model Stage 1

In Stage 1, stay home order, of the Southside Learning Model the building is closed to access for all teachers and students. In this stage students would participate in Learning 2.0 (distance learning) through the Southside School District. Methods for instruction in this stage include:

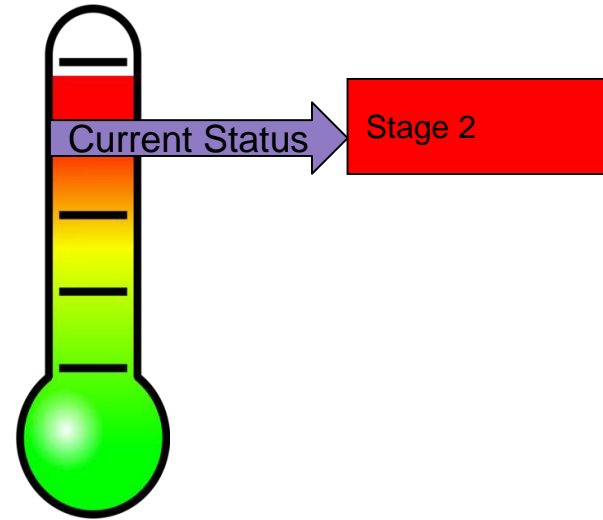
- Synchronous instruction provided through Google Meets or Zoom.
- Asynchronous instruction provided through Curriculum or staff created video.
- Assignments, resources, and new learning provided to students through Google Classroom.
- Office hours for teachers through Google Meets or Zoom, email, or phone.
- Paper and pencil offerings, if necessary, closely linked to online model.



Southside Learning Model Stage 2

Stage 2 of the Southside Learning Model includes all of the parameters from Stage 1, but teachers have limited access to the school buildings for planning purposes and to provide instruction.

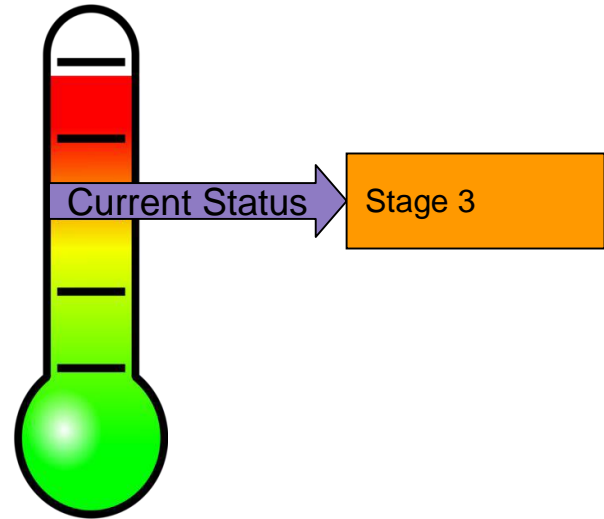
- All OSPI, L&I, and Health Department Protocols will be followed.



Southside Learning Model Stage 3

In Stage 3 of the Southside Learning Model all parameters of Stage 2 are included as well as face to face instruction of students identified with having the greatest need:

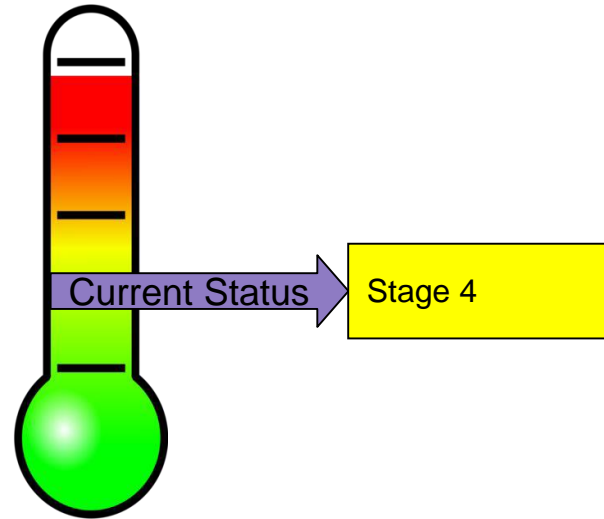
- Need of students will be identified based on an agreed upon set criteria.
- Students identified will participate in face to face instruction two days per week.
- All OSPI, L&I, and Department of Health protocols will be followed.
- Staff are onsite.
- Families may opt to continue participating in Continuous Learning 2.0



Southside Learning Model Stage 4

In Stage 4 of the Southside Learning Model all students are able to return in a hybrid model (AA/BB) two days a week for face to face instruction with remote learning 3 days per week:

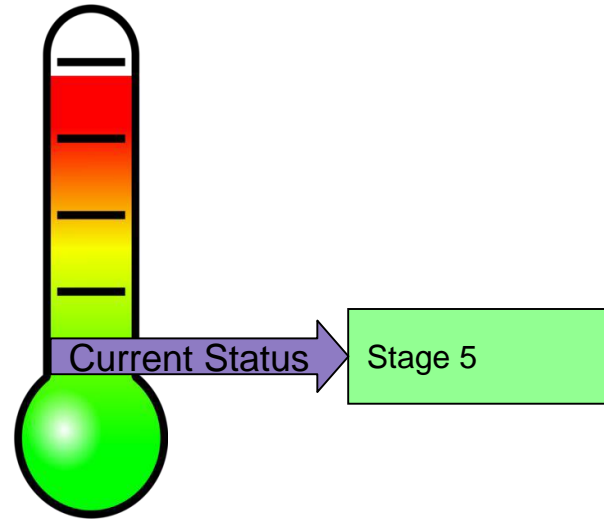
- Additional students of need identified based on agreed upon set criteria.
- Students will attend set days based on last name, siblings, etc.
- All OSPI, L&I, and Department of Health protocols will be followed.
- Staff are onsite unless approved directly for remote instruction or work.
- Families may opt to continue participating in



Southside Learning Model Stage 5

In Stage 5 of the Southside Learning Model all students are able to attend school four days a week for face to face instruction with one day for remote focus:

- Students identified will participate in face to face instruction four days per week.
- All OSPI, L&I, and Department of Health protocols will be followed.
- Families may opt to continue participating in Continuous Learning 2.0



Southside Learning Model Stage 6

Stage 6 of the Southside Learning Model is a full return to face to face instruction five days per week:

- All OSPI, L&I and Department of Health protocols will be followed.
- Families may opt to continue participating in Continuous Learning 2.0 until designated by State or OSPI regulation.
